Mark: when ye shall see the abomination of desolation


Luke: when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies

Luke: For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side

Cestius Gallus's sudden departure from the siege of Jerusalem in 66AD, gave the Christians the

sign Yeshua had prophesied. This is described in "War of the Jews", by Flavius Josephus. No Christians died in 70AD.

Daniel 9:26

Daniel 11:31

And armies shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily *sacrifice*, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate
